His birth history was significant for a transverse lie and a difficult C-section delivery.

While working with Pamela Curlee during his reflex repatterning session, on perhaps the fifth or sixth day, he had an amazing experience. Pamela was working with his spinal reflexes and head crowning. She shifted her focus to more work with the head crowning, and Zachary followed spontaneously with what I now know to be the sequence of birthing reflexes. He then got off the table and began exploring the room like he had never been in there before, studying the space and items in it with intensity. We both stared and watched

him and Pamela said to me, "He just went through the birth process!" I cried, she cried, as the true significance of what had just happened hit us both.

By the end of the conference, he was present to us, interactive in a way he had never been before, and had more confidence initiating conversations with people he didn't know.

At 15, he attended a second five day Family Conference because he was still experiencing some challenges with his strength and coordination.

Zack is now 16 and a honors junior in high school, active in marching band as well as Boy Scouts, where he is a Life Scout. He is bright and funny and an absolutely great young man!
